defab® are industry leaders of industrial fabrics, manufacturing and producing quality products that surpass stringent standards for durability and performance.

defab® camperfield® is an acrylic coated polyester fabric used for annex walling and is regarded as mildew proof. (defab® camperfield® is guaranteed for 2 years).

defab® duracoat® is an acrylic coated polyester/cotton fabric used in annex roofing, tarpaulins, box trailers etc. and is rated as mildew resistant (due to the protective coating applied). (defab® tearlok® proofed range is guaranteed for 5 years).

defab® tearlok® is an acrylic proofed polyester/cotton fabric used in annex roofing, tarpaulins, box trailers etc, and is rated as mildew resistant (due to the protective coating applied). (defab® tearlok® proofed range is guaranteed for 5 years).

defab® supaproof® is an acrylic proofed polyester/cotton fabric used in annex roofing, tarpaulins, box trailers etc, and is rated as mildew resistant (due to the protective coating applied). (defab® supaproof® is guaranteed for 5 years).

defab® guarantees that its outdoor canvas fabrics are capable of withstanding outdoor conditions for a number of years, except where severe or out of the usual abrasion and/or mechanical stresses are evident or encountered

defab®will, at it's discretion, replace or restore to sound condition, fabric which has failed to provide satisfactory service within the relevant product guarantee period from the date of purchase.

This guarantee is offered inclusive of the 12 months required by Australian State Laws and is offered subject to the following:

- The fabric concerned is not subjected to unreasonable treatment, or extraordinary conditions and is maintained in accordance with the defab®canvas care instructions provided with this product
- The customer acknowledges and accepts that the occasional occurrence of varn slubs and knots is characteristic of canvas fabrics and may be more evident in some colours and translucent products.

Claims against this guarantee must be made through the fabricator or supplier of the finished product.

This guarantee relates only to defab® products camperfield®, duracoat®, defab® tearlok® (proofed range is guaranteed for 5 years) and supaproof®. It doesn't extend to work of others; in particular, it excludes manufacture and installation by others, hardware and accessories. Nor is the cost of dismantling, transportation, re-erection, travelling costs or consequential loss covered by this defab® quarantee.

## **Canvas Care Instructions**

To help maximise the durability and life of your defab® Canvas, please follow the following instructions thoroughly – this will allow you to enjoy many years of excellent service and satisfaction from your defab® canvas.

- Prior to using your defab® canvas we recommend that you thoroughly wet your canvas with a domestic hose
  and let it dry fully in the sun. This is necessary to allow the fabric to settle after transport and packaging.
   Failure to do this may cause leakage in initial exposure to rain.
- · Store, pack or roll up only when clean and dry.
- To remove dirt, brush dry fabric with soft brush. (An occasional hosing may remove dust and some ingrained dirt)
- Never scrub the fabric.
- Do not expose to petrol or oil.
- Immediately remove deposits of organic matter (such as soil, grass cuttings, leaf litter, bird droppings, vehicle exhaust, pollutants, etc)
- Remove any mildew, as it appears, first by brushing, then by treating with diluted chlorine bleach (typically
  1 part White King to 4 parts water to achieve 1% available chlorine) Allow to dry in full sun, then hose well to
  remove any residue.
- Do not use strong bleaches such as 'pool chlorine'.
- Do not use soaps, detergents, solvents, or other liquid cleaners.

Exposure to the elements and excessive cleaning may affect the water proofness and appearance of the canvas. Occasional rejuvenation of your canvas is recommended. Additional proofing may help re-invigorate the canvas. Only use one type of proofing agent on your canvas. Fluoro-chemicals like Scotch guard may be used on all fabrics. Only reproof® by defab® is recommended to be used on defab® canvas.
