CANVAS CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Before use thoroughly wet your new canvas and let it dry fully in the sun. Failure to do so may cause leakage during initial exposure to rain.
- Canvas must be completely dry and clean prior to storage.
- Do not expose to petrol, oil, or solvents.
- Clean only with cold water and a soft brush. Do not scrub the fabric.
- Do not use soaps, detergents, or strong bleaches such as 'pool chlorine'.
- Immediately remove deposits of organic matter such as soil, grass cutting, leaf litter, bird droppings, vehicle exhaust, pollutants, etc.
- Should mildew appear, remove first by softly brushing. Then by treating with diluted chlorine bleach (1 part liquid bleach to 4 parts water). Rinse well and dry fully.
- Occasional rejuvenation of your canvas is suggested using Reproof by Defab - a canvas treatment to keep your fabrics protected and long-lasting.
